

Feel free to send this to your team members and let me know if your team is short. I know where to find some help!



#### We Will Miss You Ed Stanfield!!

Ed Stanfield, one the 1 st Wednesday Team from Westover Hills Presbyterian Church, has worked at Stewpot for over 15 years. Ed is not your typical Stewpot worker. On the first Wednesday of each month, Ed arrives at the Stewpot about 9:30 a.m. On his way to the Stewpot, Ed stops by Community Bakery and picks up day old desserts for the Stewpot patrons. The desserts and pastries are contained in large plastic containers. Ed must return these containers to Community Bakery when Stewpot is over. Ed carries the containers to the second floor and arranges all of the desserts on trays so they can easily be served. Tammy Pflug, another member of our team, usually serves desserts at Stewpot, but she has a full time job and doesn't arrive until about 11:45 a.m. When she arrives, the desserts are ready to be served. On the days that Co-Captains Charlie and Charlotte Frith go to LifeQuest on the 1st Mednesday, they arrive at the


vvculicouay, they allive at the IO FIICANCSI OII IIIC I Stewpot about 10:15. When this occurs, Ed along with Fred Whitmore, is always willing to start preparing the food prior to the Frith's arrival. The Stewpot stopped serving milk about three years ago because of the expense. When the Stewpot stopped serving milk, Ed started picking up 3 gallons of milk and bringing it to Stewpot. The First Wednesday of each month is the only day that Stewpot patrons receive milk - and only because of Ed. Food is typically served to Stewpot patrons as they come up the staircase to the second floor. We usually serve "Seconds" in the main dining room. Seconds consist of leftovers from the previous day. If there are no leftovers, something must be prepared that is different from the main meal. Ed is our "Seconds Man" and always serves the seconds. Ed emailed me the other day that he had recently had a birthday and was now 86 years young, and that he was going to retire from Stewpot at the end of the year. Ed, we wish you well, but we are really going to miss you. We will probably have to replace you with two people. The best of luck to you from your Stewpot Team - Charlie and Charlotte Frith, Fred Whitmore, Tammy Pflug, H.K. Stewart, Joyce Wilson, Dwane Tankersley and Brad Jakel.


