

# Stewpot Receives Socks and Underwear from Bombas



In May 2025, Little Rock Stewpot received 12 boxes containing a total of 3,000 pairs of Bombas

socks. Socks included various sizes and included both over the calf and ankle socks.

A month later Stewpot received 29 boxes containing a total of 2200 pieces of Bombas underwear. The underwear included various sizes of men's boxers and T-shirts and various sizes of Women's T-shirts and briefs.

Due to lack of storage space at The Salvation Army facility, the socks and underwear were shipped and stored at Ferncliff. Emily Hooker, Director of Mission & Outreach for Ferncliff Camp and Conference Center, was responsible for storing and distributing the socks. Bombas socks and underwear cannot be sold but can be donated to charities and nonprofit organizations.







## 1st Wednesday Group Prepares Stewpot Meal

The 1st Wednesday Group assembled at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, May 7th, and prepared 72 meals for the Stewpot diners. The 1st Wednesday group is composed of individuals primarily from Westover Hills Presbyterian Church along with a few members from other churches. The meal included a cup of hot Hoppin' John, a cup of sliced peaches, a peanut butter sandwich (jelly was included in a separate package), a bag of chips, and a plastic spoon. Jason prepared the Hoppin' John which is a hearty Southern dish of rice, ham, turnip greens, tomatoes, chicken broth, garlic, salt, pepper, Cajun

#### Jason Cooks Special Meal for Stewpot

Jason, Stewpot Day Manager, is always looking for new menu items for the Stewpot diners. On Wednesday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, he cooked Shepherd's Pie.

Shepherd's pie is a traditional British casserole typically made with a ground meat and vegetable filling, topped with mashed potatoes. While often called "shepherd's pie," it's also known as "cottage pie," and some recipes may use beef instead of lamb. The key difference between the two is the meat: shepherd's pie traditionally uses ground lamb, while cottage pie uses ground beef.

Jason used ground beef, mixed vegetables, sauteed onions and peppers, salt, pepper, garlic beef gravy with mashed potatoes on top. It was delicious!



#### **Stewpot ReceivesGrant**



Last month the Arkansas Food Bank brought to our attention that nonprofits working with them could apply for up to \$5,000 to build up their organizational capacity to feed the food-insecure people we serve. Stewpot decided that helping with the repair of our walk-in freezer was the highest priority. The grant was submitted, and we were notified that we will be receiving the full \$5,000. This will give Stewpot more freezer storage space to accept donations. The total cost for the repair of the walk-in freezer will be approximately \$15,000. Stewpot will be looking for additional funding to complete the project.



#### **STEWPOT Celebrates Jason's Birthday**

On Wednesday, May 14th, the Stewpot helped Jason celebrate his 43rd birthday. Jason is the Day manager of the Stewpot and is responsible for the daily operations. Jason plans and cooks many of the meals for the Stewpot diners.

Wellcare, Allwell, Ambetter, Arkansas Total Care and QualChoice of AR and is owned by St. Louis-based Centene Corporation.




